The entrance was not located although the landowner later reported that he knows where it is and also that it is blocked with stones. The passage was discovered earlier this century when a labourers cottage was being built. At the time a volunteer entered the souterraine with a hurricane lamp and reappeared shortly with the lamp extinguished and "himself upset for days".
